The LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Green Building Rating System provides a standard for defining an environmentally friendly, sustainable, "green" building. Points are awarded to construction projects based on building characteristics like water savings, energy efficiency, indoor air quality, and the types of building materials used. The Euclid Chemical Company manufactures many products that can contribute points toward the LEED certification of a building.

Kurez DR 100, a water based curing compound that can contribute to the LEED points of a building based on its "low-emitting" qualities; that is, this product has a volatile organic compound (VOC) content of 95 grams per liter.

Kurez DR 100 is manufactured in Cleveland, Ohio. If Cleveland, Ohio, falls within a 500-mile radius of the project site, the product is considered to be a locally produced material and can help contribute to earning (MR) Regional Materials Credit.

No single extracted material is used to produce the majority of this product. Additionally, all raw materials come from one of several sources which in-turn come from one of several raw material feed stocks. As such, point source for the raw materials cannot be determined.
